## **Anti-sect Movement Against Chaitanya Mission**

HRWF (15.04.1999) - The lawsuit opposing Chaitanya Mission (a Hindu religious minority in Poland) and Anna Lobaczewska, president of the Movement to protect the Family and the Individual.

On 17 March 1999, priest Jacek Galuszka, the following witness of Ms Lobaczewska, testified during the court appearance in Krakow. Priest Galuszka is a friend of Ms Lobaczewska and the founder of the Dominican Center of Information about Sects and New Religious Movements in Krakow.

During his testimony, priest Galuszka stated very clearly that he received all the information concerning Chaitanya Mission from Ms Lobaczewska who first began to libel this religious movement publicly.

The only argument that Jacek Galuszka had to support his statement that Chaitanya Mission is a sect, was that it treats the teachings of the Catholic Church selectively. He also said that he had never personally verified the information he had about Chaitanya Mission neither with its leader nor with any or its present members. He had never been to any Chaitanya Mission centers and never participated in any of its public lectures.

The leader of Chaitanya Mission Elzbieta Serwin enclosed a letter to priest Jacek Galuszka in the files. In this letter, one of the Chaitanya Mission members described the principles followed by the monks from one of the Catholic monasteries in Krakow which are very similar to the principles followed by the Chaitanya Mission members. She also included Galuszka's answer to this letter in which he asks for more detailed information about the name of this monastery, because - as he says - if this is a Catholic monastery, it is definitely not a sect. If the presented group is not a Catholic one, it can be a dangerous sect.

Jacek Galuszka is the leader of the Dominican Center of Information about New Religious Movements and Sects and still spreads false and offensive information about Chaitanya Mission.
